

APPLICATION FOR HORSE RIDING WARNING SIGNS TO BE COMPLETED BY THE APPLICANT

- 1. Application to be granted if an open bridleway/byway/green lane crosses the highway, including a staggered crossing requiring riders to use a section of the highway connecting the above. Consideration will also be given to other equestrian access points on the highway i.e. local facility where horse riders may meet and congregate.
- 2. Applicant to specify location and length of normal route taken
- 3. Police accident history and incident history involving vehicles, pedestrians and horses will be taken into consideration. The Authority will also contact the British Horse Society on the applicant's behalf to ascertain their views on the proposed location.
- 4. Visibility criteria where traffic volumes exceed 3000 per day, signs will be considered on their merits without need to meet visibility criteria. Where traffic volumes falls below this figure the sign will only be considered if the approach visibility is less than

- 85%ile speed up to 40mph 80m
- 85%ile speed 40 50 mph 120m
- 85%ile speed 50 60 mph 160m
- 85%ile speed over 60mph 210 m
