

## 2021 Census Data for Carmarthenshire – Ethnic Group

The Office for National Statistics has used a new statistical disclosure control methodology for Census 2021. As a result, figures created by summing lower-level geographies will not match figures released for higher geographies. The Office for National Statistics does not recommend the aggregation of lower-level geographies to create higher geographies.

## 2021 Census Data for Carmarthenshire – Ethnic Group

### Analysis:

- *The majority of people in Carmarthenshire identify as English/Welsh/Scottish/Northern Irish/ British (94.0%). Although this has decreased from the 2011 Census where 95.6% of people identified within this group.*
- *The Ethnic groups identified with the least in Carmarthenshire was 'other black' and 'Roma' (0.0%), with only 69 people selecting this as their ethnicity. The 'Roma' ethnic group was included in the Gypsy or Irish Traveller figures for the 2011 Census.*
- *The total of those identifying themselves as 'white' has increased by 1.3% since 2011.*
- *2021 sees a proportional percentage increase in most the ethnic groups since 2011.*
  - *'Any other' group: 0.1% increase*
  - *'Arab' group: remains the same*
  - *'Mixed or multiple ethnic groups': 0.3% increase,*
  - *'Black, Black British, Black Welsh, Caribbean or African' group: 0.1% increase*
  - *'Asian' group: 0.2% increase.*

### Definition:

*The ethnic group that the person completing the census feels they belong to. This could be based on their culture, family background, identity or physical appearance.*
